

The SIPOC Map provides a high-level overview of the process that is in scope. The map details the suppliers, inputs, processes, outputs, and customers involved in the process.

Define the process at the “macro” level

- Suppliers: Who provides the Inputs?
- Inputs: What goes into the Process?
- Process: How is the Process performed?
- Outputs: What comes out of the Process?
- Customers: Who receives the Outputs?

Steps for Completing the SIPOC Map

1. Start with Process, try to classify the process in four to six high-level process steps.
2. Identify the Outputs of the Process.
3. Identify the Customers of the Outputs.
4. Identify the Inputs required for the Process to function.
5. Identify the Suppliers of the Inputs that are required by the Process.
