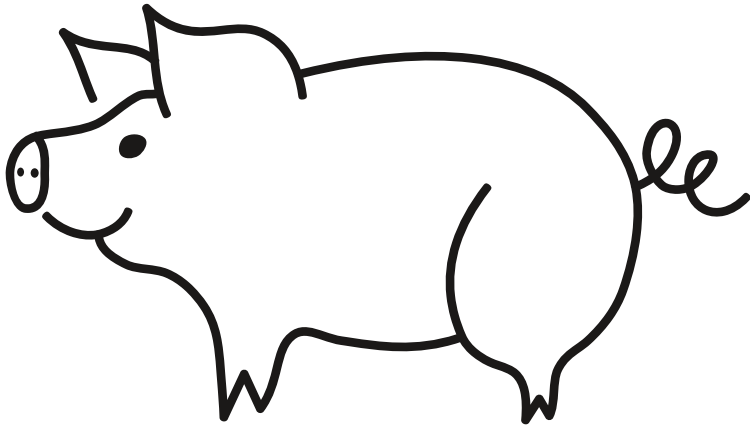


Pig Profile Personality Test



Pig Personality Test Directions

This icebreaker is not scientific, but it's good for a lot of laughs. Gets people thinking and talking themselves and sets the stage for a good team-building experience.

- Provide each team member with a blank piece of 8 ½ x 11 paper and a drawing utensil (pencil, pen, etc.).
- Draw a pig.

Once the team has finished drawing their pigs and are satisfied with the result, share the instructions on how to interpret the pig drawings. Using the tables provided, help each team member match the characteristics of their pig drawing, to what those characteristics indicate about that person's personality.

Placement on Page

Toward the top of the page	You are positive and optimistic
Toward the middle of the page	You are a realist
Toward the bottom of the page	You are pessimistic and tend to play the devil's advocate role

Orientation of Pig

Pig is facing left	Traditional, friendly, tend to be introverted, good with numbers
Pig is facing right	Innovative, active, tend to be extroverted, good with words
Pig is facing straight forward	You are not afraid of conflict

Level of Detail

Pig drawn with a lot of detail	You are analytical and may need a lot of information before making a decision
Pig drawn with very few details	You are comfortable flying by the seat of your pants and are a risk taker

Pig Features

Pig has 4 legs	You are secure and you stick to your ideals
Pig has 2 legs	You are currently going through a major change
Size of the ears	The larger the ears, the better listener you are
Length of tail	The longer the tail, the more hungry you are for some bacon
